Shirts <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cotton 	Short or long sleeve three button polo-style knit with collar	White Navy Blue Dark Green	Shirts must be solid with NO logos. PTA Hawk Shirts may be worn any day. Undershirts worn under uniform shirts must be solid white or PE uniform. Oversized shirts are NOT permitted. Shirts must be tucked in at the waist with the belt visible from 8:23 to 3:30.
Pants and Shorts <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cotton • Twill/Poplin • Corduroy 	Tailored with straight legs Appropriate length is required	Khaki/Tan Navy Blue	Must fit snugly at the waist, be hemmed, not touch the ground or be cut at the seam. Baggy or oversized styles are NOT permitted. Spandex or stretch is NOT permitted. NO JEAN STYLES – Uniform style only Length for shorts must be no shorter than three inches above the knee.
Skirts Skorts Jumpers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cotton • Twill/Poplin • Corduroy 	Straight Pleated	Khaki/Tan Navy Blue	Length must be no shorter than three inches above the knee. Stretch and spandex are NOT permitted.
Sweatshirts and Sweaters <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cotton 	Long Sleeve Pullover	Navy Blue Dark Green White	Must be solid with NO logos. SWMS sweatshirts are permitted. Jackets and coats will NOT be allowed in classrooms.
Belts		Khaki, Black, Navy, White, or Brown	Must fit waist and be visible Belt Buckles may not be excessive in size
Shoes	Must have a back or heel strap Must be tied and Velcro straps secure	Navy Blue, Gray, White, Brown, Black	Shower shoes, water shoes, flip-flops are NOT allowed. May have accent colors if they do not cover more than 25% of shoe Shoes/boots that come above the ankle should be worn with pants. Tennis shoes are strongly encouraged
Jewelry	Earrings – Boys may wear stud earrings only Earrings – Girls may wear earrings that are not distracting		No visible body piercing or tattoos including drawing on self with markers and pens Necklaces and bracelets must be tasteful and not excessive
Hats, Hairnets, Doo-rags, Sweatbands, and Bandanas are not allowed in school. Hair should be neat and well-groomed. Hair color must be a natural color. No facial hair is permitted.
